Research and Recommendations for the juvenile justice system

Goal: The Tribal Juvenile Justice Council (TJJC) collaborates with agencies, organization and individuals serving tribal communities to maximize best practice approaches for positive youth development.

Objective A: The TJJC will research and provide information on the importance of effective policies and practices that encourage and support the role and responsibilities of parents.

Objective B: The TJJC shares information with members on any available resources, programs, and training for further dissemination to stakeholders

Objective C: support development of accurate census for the 10 to 17 year-old population in each tribal community

Strategic Area: Developing Tribal Assets

Goal 1: Idaho Tribal Youth will have a voice at Tribal/local, state and national levels

Objective A: Support Youth Council with each tribe through activities such as participating in UNITY events and other Youth leadership activities.

Objective B: Have youth representation on the IJJ Youth Committee
